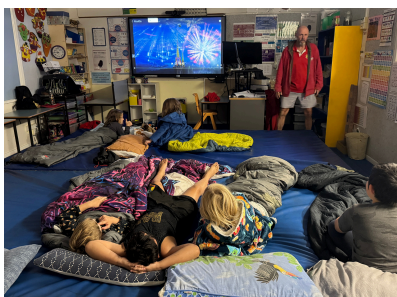


School Excursion and Sleepover
